Volunteer community scientists support the community-based Genetics of Taste Lab by collecting, processing and preparing DNA samples, sequencing DNA and entering data into our database.

This program is open to high school students who are juniors or seniors in the spring of 2018. Applicants must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a science-related career during their applications, essays and interviews.

Applicants must be able to volunteer for a minimum of 20 shifts (100 hours) within one year. Shifts offerings include school breaks, holidays, evening and special events!

Training and bus passes will be provided. Bilingual (Spanish/ English) is a plus!
